INSPECTION

nspection should be performed monthly or nore frequently if circumstances warrant. Check the following:

- 1.) The unit should be free of any damage.
- 2.) The nozzle and or hose should be shecked to assure it is free of any blockage.
- 3.) The gauge should show the proper charge pressure as indicated by the indicator being within the printed green range.
- 4.) Visually inspect the seal that secures the safety pin in place, and that it is in good condition. 5.) Visually inspect that the operating nstructions and inspection tags are clearly visible, completely legible and current.

MAINTENANCE

Annual Maintenance is a more complete inspection of the extinguisher and should be done by an authorized professional. Close inspection will reveal the necessity of a hydrostatic test, which is required every five years on water-based extinguishers. (Note: This is not required on the disposable / recyclable canister type fire extinguishers.)

AFTER USE

All refillabel extinguishers should be mmediately recharged. Rechargeable extinguishers shall be serviced by an authorized FireStopper® Distributor. Moduar pre-charged canister extinguishers are designed to be serviced directly by the end user as described within these instructions.

INSTALLATION

Install, inspect, maintain and test your fire extinguisher in accordance with the National Fire Protection Association Standard Number 10 labeled "Portable Fire Extinguishers" or its closest intent as applicable.

Your fire extinguisher should be mounted/maintained in a clean, dry area, easily accessible to possible fire hazards, clear of obstructions and if possible near an exit. Mount your extinguisher at a level of 3½ to 5 feet from the floor and out of the reach of young children.

Use the mounting bracket provided with your extinguisher (if applicable) or an approved FireStopper® vehicle bracket (optional) if required. Always fasten to a solid surface using strong screws or fasteners (not included).

Follow the mounting instructions below, particularly in public areas where the extinguisher may become dislodged from the bracket or have objects placed or hung on it.

MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

UL specifies that a hanging device must withstand a vertical force equal to five times the weight of the charged extinguisher but not less than one hundred pounds. The bracket should be mounted as follows:

Walls where 2" x 4" studs can be found:

All size extinguishers.

Mount the wall hanger bracket using two number 12 wood screws 11/4" long directly into the stud.

Sheet Rock:

All size extinguishers.

Mount a ¾" thick board to the wall using 3/16" toggle bolts. The extinguisher dimensions should determine the height and width of the board. The board should extend a minimum of two inches past all sides of the extinguisher profile. Mount the wall hanger bracket to the board using two number 10 wood screws one inch in length.

Cinder Block or Concrete:

All size extinguishers.

Mount wall bracket using one ¼" toggle bolt or masonry lead screw expansion anchor and bolt.

Tile Walls:

All size extinguishers.

Mount wall bracket using one ¼" toggle bolt or masonry lead screw expansion anchor. Locate anchor in tile joint.

Steel Posts or Beams:

All size extinguishers.

Special tools and fasteners are required. Have the extinguisher mounted by a professional fire extinguisher service company.

INSPECTION

Inspection should be performed monthly or more frequently if circumstances warrant. Check the following:

- 1.) The unit should be free of any damage.
- 2.) The nozzle and or hose should be checked to assure it is free of any blockage. 3.) The gauge should show the proper charge pressure as indicated by the needle being within the printed green range.
- 4.) The seal that secures the safety pin in place should be in tact and in good condition.
- 5.) Inspect that the operating instructions are clearly visible and complete.

IN CASE OF FIRE

- 1. Have everyone evacuate the area immediately.
- 2. Call the Fire Department immediately, even if the fire appears to be small. Small fires can quickly become large fires. The Fire Department phone number should be posted at every phone or call 911.

HOW TO USE

NOTE: The following instructions are of a general nature, and intended only to familiarize the user with the basic care and operation techniques of FireStopper® Hand Portable Fire Extinguishers. All hand portable extinguishers operate by removing the safety pin with a twisting motion to break the plastic seal and then squeezing the handles together. Since extinguishers differ, the extinguisher nameplate must be consulted for specific procedures, fire classes and starting distances.

- 1.) Hold extinguisher upright and pull the safety pin using a twisting motion to break the plastic seal.
- 2.) Stand back from the fire the proper distance as directed on the nameplate on the extinguisher body. Aim at the base of the fire starting with the fire closest to you.
- 3.) While keeping the extinguisher upright squeeze the handles together to discharge and sweep from side to side. Move closer as the fire is extinguished, but not too close as to spread the burning material or liquid.
- **4.)** When the fire is out back away and observing for possible re-ignition.
- 5.) Evacuate and ventilate the effected areas immediately. The fumes and smoke from any fire may be hazardous and can be deadly.

Remember this simple word. PASS = Pull, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep

NOTE: When possible, protective clothing and breathing equipment should be used while fighting a fire.

SPECIAL AFTER USE INSTRUCTIONS

When using disposable models, follow these simple steps to replace your extinguisher:

- 1. After the extinguisher is used, make sure that the fire is totally extinguished. Discharge any remaining liquid or gas pressure.
- 2. Deposit used extinguisher in your recycling bin. The extinguisher is 100% recyclable.
- 3. Replace the used-up extinguisher immediately with a new, fully charged extinguisher whenever possible. Do not expose yourself, your loved ones or your personal property to unnecessary danger. One never knows when fire will strike again.

Please read it completely and keep it accessible so that it may be reviewed on a periodic basis. OSHA requires training of personnel who might be expected to use an extinguisher in an emergency. Familiarity with this manual and the instruction nameplate on the extinguisher will contribute to the successful use of the extinguisher. You should know what it CAN and CANNOT do, where it is located, how to use it and how to maintain it. Proper and effective use of any fire extinguisher begins with the understanding of the classes of fire. Different types of extinguishers are rated for different classes and sizes of fires. Some are rated for single classifications and others constitute a hazard in used on certain types of fires.
